- Candidates are asked to take note of the following requirements as well as policies and procedures for the PRS Examination.
- 1. General Information on the PRS Examination**
 - Number of questions: 100 (multiple choice)
 - Duration: 90 minutes
 - Passing mark: 70%
 - Language: English, Bahasa Malaysia and Chinese
 - 2. Candidate Examination No. and Admission Ticket**
 - Candidates successfully registered for a PRS Examination will receive a candidate examination number from the PRS Parallel (PLP), International PRS (IPLP) or Corporate PRS adviser (CPA) as well as an admission ticket which referred to as "Admission Ticket". Admission Tickets will be issued by candidates prior to the examinations.
 - Candidate Examination No. is required to take the PRS Examination. Please make sure that you have the candidate study guide to the examination.
 - 3. Location and Time:**
 - For a map and direction to the respective centre kindly visit www.fimm.org.my and click "PRC Examinations".
 - Allow yourself plenty of time to get to the PRS Examination Centre. FIMM recommends that you visit your PRN Examination centre prior to examination day to familiarize with traffic patterns, parking availability, and public transportation routes or alternatives.
 - Candidates should arrive at the PRS Examination Centres, least 30 minutes before the start of the examination proper. Candidates arriving at the PRS Examination centre after that time during the examination has started will not be admitted.
 - 4. Examination Site Coordinator (ESC)**
 - ESC will be stationed in the examination room to assist candidates and ensure that examination adhere to PRS Examination requirements, policies and procedures. Should you require any assistance, please approach ESC for help. Questions concerning the conduct of the examination will not be entertained.
 - Candidates should listen carefully to and understand the instructions and directions given by ESC.
 - 5. Admission and Attendance**
 - Candidates must present their valid Admission Ticket together with original identity documents (i.e. Identity Card or Passport) for verification before admission into the examination room. The ESC will deny admission to anyone who does not present a valid Admission Ticket and identity documents.
 - The following information will be verified by ESC before admission into the examination room:
 - (i) Candidate's Full Name;
 - (ii) IC No. or Passport No; and
 - (iii) Candidate Examination No. (to be stamped from whom candidate is entitled to sit for).
 - Candidates with items (i) and (ii) not matching or corresponding to those present in their identity documents will be barred from entering the examination room. Such candidates will be required to leave. No refund will be given.
 - All candidates must sign on the Attendance Slip for their attendance registration purposes, failure which, candidate will be considered absent.
 - 6. Things Allowed to Bring into Examination Room**
 - Candidates are not allowed to bring with you Money Bag or Purse, non-programmable calculator and pen(s). Other personal belongings (such as soft cases, hand phones, daily calendar) and books this paper are to be left at a designated place as instructed by ESC.
 - Under FIMM, the examination centre or ESC will assume responsibility on losing, breaking, theft, or damaged of your personal property.

7. Examination Results	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The results will be made available in <u>paper</u> via the relevant company that you registered with within one month from the examination date.
8. Miscellaneous	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Candidates from firms whose exam is continuing can use simple electronic calculators, using or receiving help, working on or reading the examination questions during a time recommended by the ENSC – comprising a short answer from other examiners and/or issued paper form for a question or subject taking part in the act of discussion and/or other forms of cheating. Failure to follow the ENSC's recommendations may result in PIMM's application policies or procedures, etc., being dismissed from the examination room. In addition, you may be subjected to other form of penalties or consequences including sealing of examination results and suspension or termination of your right to sit the PRS Examination.
9. Reservation of Right during Emergencies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> FIMM may decide to change the date, time, or conditions of the administration of an examination in case of the disappearance of the examination, to check it with the candidate details, either entirely across the board or at a particular examination centre or section of PIMM, in its full and absolute discretion, determines that any re-examination is needed to protect the integrity of the PRS Examination, because administration of the examination in subsequent proceeding of the exam is hindered by any cause that could not be reasonably prevented by the FIMM, including acts of God or other natural disasters and a military authority. FIMM is not responsible or liable for any losses or other consequences arising from the abnormal events which are beyond its control. Should there be any changes in cancellation of examination sessions or exams due to unforeseen event, the relevant company will be advised and will have to apply for another PRS Examination session at an additional cost. Such application must be submitted to FIMM within <u>one month</u> from the examination date.
10. Policy Changes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ENSC may change the requirements, policies, and procedures governing the PRS Examinations from time to time. Changes, if any, will be incorporated these notes and the revised notes will be circulated to all relevant centres. Candidates are advised to check with respective relevant company on what is the latest version of the "Notes to Candidates" notice available.
11. Appeal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Requests for appeal, if any, must be submitted to the relevant company and received by FIMM within 14 days from the date of the examination result. The appeal request should be accompanied with a payment of RM20.00 as processing fee. Please contact the relevant company for further details and procedures. Requests for appeal received by FIMM later than 14 days will not be considered.
