Candidates are advised to take note of the following requirements, as well as policies and procedures for the PRS Examination.

- 1. General information on PRS Examination**
- * Number of Questions: 60 multiple-choice
 - * Duration: 30 minutes
 - * Passing mark: 50%
 - * Language: English only. Examination in Bahasa Malaysia and Chinese will be introduced with effect from 22 June 2013.
- 2. Candidate Examination No. and Admission Tickets**
- * Upon successfully registered for a PRS Examination session, candidates are required to obtain their respective Candidate Examination No. from the PRS Principle (PP), Institutional PRS Admin (PIPA) or Corporate PRS Admin (CPRA) in which they are attached, hereafter collectively referred to as "their company". Admission Tickets will be issued to candidates prior to the examination.
 - * Candidate Examination No. is required to take the PRS Examination. Please make sure that you have the number ready prior to the examination.
- 3. Location and Time**
- * For a map and directions to the respective centre, kindly visit www.fimm.org.my and click "PRS Examination".
 - * Allow yourself plenty of time to get to the PRS Examination Centre. FIMM recommends that you check your PRS Examination centre prior to examination day to familiarise with traffic patterns, parking availability, and public transportation options or restrictions.
 - * Candidates should arrive at the PRS Examination Centres at least 30 minutes before the start of the examination programme. Candidates arriving at the PRS Examination centre later than 15 minutes after the examination has started will not be admitted.
- 4. Examination Site Coordinator (ESC)**
- * ESC will be situated in the examination room to assist candidates and ensure that candidates adhere to the PRS Examination requirements, policies and procedures. Should you require any assistance, please approach ESC for help. Questions concerning the conduct of the examination will not be entertained.
 - * Candidates should listen carefully and understand the instructions and directions given by ESC.
- 5. Admission and Attendance**
- * Candidates must present their original Admission Tickets together with original identity documents to the Exam Centre or Passport for verification before admission into the examination rooms. The ESC will deny admittance to anyone who does not present a valid Admission Ticket and identity documents.
 - * The following information will be verified by ESC before admission into the examination room:
 - (i) Candidate's Full Name;
 - (ii) IC No. or Passport No. etc;
 - (iii) Candidate's Examination No. (to be confirmed with corporate company if indicated in item 1).
 - * Candidates with items (i) and (ii) not matching or failing to verify on those printed on their identity documents will be barred from entering the examination rooms. Such candidates will be issued a show cause notice will be given.
 - * All candidates must sign on the Attendance Slip for their attendance/timeliness purposes. Being witness, candidate will be considered as absent.
- 6. Things Allowed to Bring into Examination Room**
- * Candidates are only allowed to bring with you Identity Card or Passport, one non-programmable calculator and pencil(s). Other personal belongings such as laptops, head-phones, mobile phones, mobile phones and papers are not to be left at a designated place as instructed by the ESC.
 - * Neither FIMM, the examination centre nor ESC will assume responsibility or liability for any loss, theft, or damage of your personal property.

- 7. Examination Results**
- * The results will be made available to you via the relevant company that you registered with ~~within one month from the examination date.~~
- 8. Misconduct**
- * Candidates found to misbehave during the examination from tampering, distract other candidates, giving or receiving help, writing on or making the examination documents illegible, using unauthorised paper or attempting to obtain answers from other sources, removing and/or leaving paper from the examination centre during participation, or passing information or other forms of cheating, failing to follow the ESC's instructions, or not complying with FIMM's regulations, policies or procedures etc., may be dismissed from the examination room. In addition, you may be subject to other form of penalties of misconduct, including voiding of examination results and suspension or revocation of your right to sit the PRS Examination.
- 9. Reservation of Right during Emergency**
- * FIMM may decide to change the date, time, or conditions of the administration of the examination if it deems the administration of the examination at those times to risk the candidates' health, either entirely across the board or at a particular examination centre or centres if FIMM, in its sole and absolute discretion determines that any such action is needed to protect the integrity of the PRS Examination, or because administration of the examination at a particular place/time of the results is hindered by any factor that could not be reasonably presented by the FIMM, including acts of God or other natural disasters and a military authority. FIMM is not responsible or liable for any loss or other consequence arising from the above said events which are beyond its control.
 - * Should there be any changes or cancellations of examination sessions or results due to the abovementioned event, the relevant company will be notified and will have to register for another PRS Examination centre at an additional cost. Such registration must be submitted to FIMM within one month from the examination date.
- 10. Policy Changes**
- * FIMM may change the requirements, policies and procedures governing the PRS Examination from time to time. Changes, if any, will be incorporated in these notes and the revised notes will be circulated to all relevant companies.
 - * Candidates are advised to check with respective relevant company to ensure that the latest version of the "Notes to Candidates" is made available.
- 11. Appeal**
- * Requests for appeal, if any, may be submitted to the relevant company and received by FIMM within 14 days from the date of the examination results. The appeal request should be accompanied with a payment of RM20.00 as processing fee. Please contact the relevant company for further details and procedure.
 - * Requests for appeal received by FIMM later than 14 days will not be considered.
