Candidates are advised to take note of the following requirements as well as policies and procedures for the PRS Examination.

- 1. General Information on PRS Examination**
- * Number of questions: 60 (multiple-choice)
 - * Duration: 90 minutes
 - * Passing mark: 70%
 - * Language: English only. Examinations in Bahasa Melayu and Chinese will be introduced with effect from 1st July 2011.
- 2. Candidate Examination No. and Admission Ticket**
- * Those successfully registered for a PRS Examination will be issued an electronic or paper-based Candidate Identification No. from the PRS Provider (PRP), Institutional PRS Admins (IPA) or Corporate PRS Admins (CPA) in whom they are enroled. (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Institutional Administrators"). Admission Tickets will be issued to candidates prior to the examination.
 - * Candidate Examination No. is required to take the PRS Examination. Please make sure that you have the admission ticket prior to the examination.
- 3. Location and Time**
- * For a map and direction to the respective centres, kindly visit www.fimm.com.my and click "PRS Examination".
 - * Allow yourself plenty of time to get to the PRS Examination centre. FIMM recommends that you visit your PRS Examination centre prior to examination day to familiarize with traffic patterns, parking availability, and public transportation options to examination sites.
 - * Candidates should arrive at the PRS Examination Centre at least 30 minutes before the start of the examination session. Candidates arriving at the PRS Examination centre later than 15 minutes after the examination has started will not be admitted.
- 4. Examination Site Coordinator (ESC)**
- * ESC will be assigned to the examination room to assist candidates and ensure that candidates adhere to the PRS Examination requirements, policies and procedures. Should you require any assistance, please approach ESC for help. Questions concerning the content of the examination will not be answered.
 - * Candidates should listen carefully to and understand all instructions and directions given by ESC.
- 5. Admission and Attendance**
- * Candidates must present their original Admission Ticket together with original identity documents (e.g. Identity Card or Passport) for verification before admittance into the examination room. The ESC will deny admittance to anyone who does not present a valid Admission Ticket and identity documents.
 - * The following information will be verified by ESC before admittance into the examination room:
(a) Candidate's Full Name;
(b) IC No. or Passport No. and;
(c) Candidate Examination No. (to be obtained from relevant website as mentioned in Note 1).
 - * Candidates with items (a) and (b) not matching or corresponding to those provided from identity documents will be barred from entering the examination room. Such candidate will be denied to sit and no refund will be given.
 - * All candidates must sign on the Attendance Slip for their attendance registration purposes, failing which, candidates will be considered as absent.
- 6. Things Allowed to Bring into Examination Room**
- * Candidates are only allowed to bring with you Identity Card, or Passport, non-programmable calculator and pencil(s). Other personal belongings such as hand bags, handphones (but excluding all mobile phones and cameras) are to be left at a designated place as instructed by the ESC.
 - * Number FIMM, the examination centre, the ESC will assume responsibility or liability for any loss, theft or damage of your personal property.

7. Examination Results
- The result will be made available to you via electronic messaging (via e-mail or mobile phone) one month from the examination date.
8. Misconduct
- Candidates shall not disclose during the examination itself anything describing other candidates, giving or receiving help, writing or drawing the examination questions during a time not approved by the FSC, or referring to other sources from other people (including oral or written paper from the examination centre), part or all of which contains material likely to assist in cheating; failing to follow the FSC's instructions; or not complying with FIMM's requirements, policies or procedures, etc., may be dismissed from the examination room. In addition, you may be subject to other forms of penalties or misconduct, including re-taking of examinations, results and suspension or termination of your right to sit for PRS Examination.
9. Reservation of Right during Emergencies
- FIMM may decide to change the date, time, or conditions of the administration of the examination or cancel the administration of the examination, or dismiss its own candidates' results, either entirely across the board or at a particular examination centre or centres if FIMM, in its sole and absolute discretion, determines that any such action is needed to protect the integrity of the PRS Examination, or because administration of the examination or subsequent processing of the results is hampered by any factor that could not be reasonably prevented by the FIMM, including acts of God (or other similar disaster) and advisory authority. FIMM is not responsible for any losses or other consequences arising from the unusual events which lie beyond its control.
 - Should there be any changes or cancellations of examination session(s) due to the unusual event, the relevant candidate will be entitled and will have to register for another PRS Examination session at no additional costs. Such registration must be submitted to FIMM within one month from the examination date.
10. Policy Changes
- FIMM may change the requirements, policies, and procedures governing the PRS Examination from time to time. Changes, if any, will be incorporated to these notes and the revised notes will be circulated to all relevant participants.
 - Candidates are advised to check with respective relevant authority to confirm that the latest version of the "Notes to Candidates" is made available.
11. Appeal
- Requests for appeal, if any, must be submitted to the relevant authority and referee by FIMM within 14 days from the date of the examination result. The appeal request should be accompanied with a payment of RM200.00 as proceeding fee. Please contact the relevant authority for further details and procedures.
 - Requests for appeal received by FIMM later than 14 days will not be considered.
