Candidates are required to satisfy one of the following requirements as well as joining and passing the PRS Examination:

1. General information on PRS Examination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of questions: 40 (one digit choice) • Duration: 90 minutes • Passing mark: 70% • Language: English only. Examinations in Italian, Spanish and Chinese will be discontinued as of effective 1st June 2011.
2. Candidates Examination No. and Admission Tickets	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon successfully registered for a PRS Examination session, candidates are required to obtain their respective Candidate Examination Nos. from the PRS Provider (PPI), Institutional PRS Advisor (IPA) or Corporate PRS Advisor (CPA) to which they are attached, from where relevant to record it as "relevant candidate". Admission Tickets will be issued at candidate point of the examination. • Candidates are required to bring it along to take the PRS Examination. Please make sure that you have the number ready prior to the examination.
3. Location and Timing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For a quick and efficient examination,考生 must visit www.fimm.it/registration and click "PRS Examination". • Allow enough time of travel to get to the PRS Examination Centre (PEC) mentioned this page, visit your PRS Examination centre prior to examination day to familiarise with traffic routes, parking availability and public transportation (if applicable conditions). • Candidates should arrive at the PRS Examination Centre at least 30 minutes before the start of the examination period. Candidates arriving at the PRS Examination centre more than 15 minutes after the examination has started will not be admitted.
4. Examination Site Coordinator (ESC)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ESC will be responsible to the examination room to assist candidates and ensure the compliance with all to the PRS Examination requirements, policies and procedures. Should you require any assistance, please approach ESC for help. Candidates understanding the conduct of the examination will not be compromised. • Candidates should bring carefully to and understand the instructions and directions given by ESC.
5. Admission and Attendance	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates must present their original Admission Tickets together with original identity documents (e.g. Identity Card or Passport) for verification before admission into the examination room. The ESC will deny admission to anyone who does not present a valid Admission Ticket and identity document. • The following information will be verified by ESC before admission into the examination room: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (i) Candidate's Full Name (ii) IC No. or Passport Number (iii) Candidate Examination No. (examination room address: company or institution office) • Candidates with items (i) and (ii) not matching or corresponding to those presented on their identity documents will be denied from entering the examination room. Such candidates will be treated as absent. No refund will be given. • All candidates must sign the Acceptance Slip for their attendance registration purposes. Failure where candidates will be considered as absent.
6. Things Allowed to Bring into Examination Room	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates are not allowed to bring with you identity Card or Passport, no programmable calculator and pencils. Other personal belongings such as mobiles, hand phones shall remain outside the room and papers can be left in a designated place as instructed by the ESC. • Under PDA, the examination centre and ESC shall assume responsibility or liability for any loss, damage or damage of your personal property.

- 1. Examination Results**
- * The results will be made available to you via the relevant company that you contacted with your application from the examination date.
- 2. Discretion**
- * Candidates should be candid during the examination (for example, admitting other candidates giving or receiving help, reading or reading the examination questions during a break not authorised by the FRC or attempting to obtain answers from other sources, referring and/or asking people from the examination centre, taking part in the act of impersonation or other form of cheating). failing to follow the FRC's instructions or not complying with FRCM requirements, rules or procedures, etc., may be removed from the examination room. In addition, you may be subject to other forms of penalties of misconduct, including scaling of examination results and suspension or cancellation of your right to sit for PRS examinations.
- 3. Reservation of Rights during Emergencies**
- * FRCM may decide to change the date, time or conditions of the administration of the examination or cancel the administration of the examination or postpone it until the conditions remain, either entirely or in part, the same or certain parts of certain FRCM decisions and ultimate discretion determines that such action is needed to protect the integrity of the PRS Examination, or because administration of the examination or subsequent processing of the results is hampered by any factor that could not be reasonably foreseen by the FRCM, including acts of God or other natural disasters and a military conflict. FRCM is not responsible or liable for any cost or other consequence arising from the aforementioned events where an emergency occurs.
 - * Should there be any changes or cancellations of examination session as result due to the上述 event, the relevant company will be notified and will have to register for another PRS Examination session at no additional costs. Such registration must be submitted to FIMM without undue delay from the cancellation date.
- 4. Policy Changes**
- * FRCM may change the requirements, policies, and procedures governing the PRS Examination. Every time to these Changes, if any, will be incorporated in these notes and the revised notes will be uploaded to all relevant companies.
 - * Candidates are advised to check with respective relevant company to update the latest version of the "Notes to Candidates" in their available.
- 5. Appeal**
- * Requests for appeal, if any, must be submitted to the relevant company and received by FRCM within 14 days from the date of the examination results. The appeal request should be accompanied with a payment of RM200 as processing fee. Please request the relevant company for further details and procedures.
 - * Requests for appeal received by FRCM after 14 days will not be considered.
