| 1. General Information on PRS Examination | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Number of questions: 60 items/questions • Duration: 90 minutes • Passing mark: 70% • Languages: English only. Examination in Tamil, Malayalam and Chinese will be implemented with effect from 27 March 2011. |
| 2. Candidate Examination No. and Admission Ticket | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Upon successful registration for a PRS Examination session, candidates are assigned a candidate examination number (e.g. FIMM Private PRS Exam No. 12345) by the Board. The Agency (FIMM) or Consociate PRS Advisor (CPA) or visiting day fee advisor (VDA) referred to as "visiting company". Admission ticket will be issued to candidates prior to the examination. • Candidate Examination No. is required to take the PRS Examination. Please make sure that you have the number ready prior to the examination. |
| 3. Location and Time | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For a map and directions to the examination centre, kindly visit www.fimm.org/fimm-examinations/ • Allow yourself plenty of time to get to the PRS Examination Centre. FIMM recommends that you visit your PRS Examination centre prior to examination day to familiarise with the location, parking availability, and public transportation options or restrictions. • Candidates should arrive at the PRS Examination Centre at least 10 minutes before the start of the examination period. Candidates arriving at the PRS Examination centre later than 10 minutes after the examination has started shall not be admitted. |
| 4. Examination Board Coordinator (EBC) | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • EBC will be present in the examination room to assist candidates and ensure that examinations adhere to the PRS Examination requirements, policies and procedures. Should you require any assistance, please approach EBC for help. Questions concerning the content of the examination will not be answered. • Candidates should dress correctly, as and understand the instructions and directions given by EBC. |
| 5. Admission and Attendance | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates must present their original documents, along together with original identity documents (e.g. Identity Card or Passport) for verification before admission into the examination room. The EBC will verify admission to examinees who does not possess a valid Admission Ticket and identity documents. • The following information will be verified by EBC before admission into the examination room: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> (a) Candidate's Full Name; (b) IC No. or Passport No.; and (c) Candidate Examination No. (to be placed free-hand copy as indicated on Slip 1). • Candidates with items (a) and (b) not matching or corresponding to those provided on their identity documents will be denied from entering the examination room. Such candidates will be turned away. No refund will be given. • All candidates must sign on the Attendant Slip in the attendance registration process, failing which, candidates will be considered as absent. |
| 6. Things Allowed in Bring into Examination Room | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Candidates are only allowed to bring with the Identity Card or Passport, one calculator and pen/pencil. Other personal belongings such as hand bags, hand phones, mobile phones, etc., books and papers are to be left in a designated place as instructed by the EBC. • Under FIMM, the examinee carries out PRS will assume responsibility personally for any loss, damage or damage to his/her personal property. |

7. Dissemination
Results
- The results will be made available to you as the relevant company that has engaged the examiners one month from the examination date.
8. Miscellaneous
- Candidates should be satisfied during the examination from example, discussing other conditions, giving or receiving advice, writing or reviewing the examination questions during a time not authorized by the PIS, or attempting to obtain access to examination papers, examining and/or copied papers from the examination room, taking part in areas of examination or office hours of cleaning, failing to follow the PIS Examination or not complying with FIMM's requirements, policies or procedures, etc., may be disqualified from the examination system. In addition, you may be subject to other form of penalties of misconduct, including revoking of examination results and suspension or termination of your registration for the PIS Examination.
9. Reservation of
Rights during
Emergency
- FIMM may decide to change the date, time, or conditions of the administration of the examination, or cancel the administration of the examination, or disallow to consider the examination results, without notice within the period of six (6) months examination date or earlier if FIMM, in sole and absolute discretion, determine that such action is needed to protect the integrity of the PIS Examination, or improve administration of the examination or subsequent proceeding of the results or handled by any factor that could not be reasonably foreseen by the FIMM, including acts of God or other natural disasters and a military authority. FIMM is not responsible for any cost or other consequences arising from the unusual circumstances beyond its control.
 - Should there be any changes or cancellation of examination session or results due to the above-mentioned, the relevant company will be notified and will have to pay the regular PIS Examination fee at no additional costs. Such notification must be received by FIMM within one month from the examination date.
10. Policy Changes
- FIMM may change the requirements, policies and procedures governing the PIS Examination from time to time. Changes, if any, will be incorporated in these notes and the revised notes will be circulated to all relevant companies.
 - Candidates are advised to check with respective relevant company to ensure that the interpretation of the "Notes to Candidates" is make clear.
11. Appeal
- Request for appeal, if any, must be submitted in the relevant company and received by FIMM within 14 days from the date of the examination results. The appeal request should be accompanied with a payment of RM200.00 as processing fee. Please contact the relevant company for further details and procedures.
 - Request for appeal received by FIMM before their 14 days will not be considered.
