Candidates are advised to take note of the following requirements as well as rights and procedures for the PRS Examination.

1. General information on PRS Examination:
 - Number of questions: 60 (multiple choice)
 - Duration: 90 minutes
 - Passing rate: 70%
 - Languages: English only. Bahasa Malaysia and Chinese will be made available in some topics
2. Candidate: Examination No. and Admission Ticket:
 - Upon successfully registered for a PRS Examination session, candidates are required to show their respective Candidate Examination No. from the PRS Examiner (P2P), Institutional PRS Advisor (IPA) or Corporate PRS Advisor (CPA), in which they are attached (belonging to) or related to an "affiliated company". Admissions Tickets will be issued to candidates prior to the examination.
 - Candidate Examination No. is required to take the PRS Examination. Please make sure that you have the number ready prior to the examination.
3. Location and Time:
 - For a map and directions to the respective centres, kindly visit www.fimm.org.my and click "PRS Examination".
 - Allow yourself plenty of time to get to the PRS Examination Centre. PRS examinations that you can take your PRS Examination centre post to examination day to familiarise with traffic patterns, parking availability, and public transportation options if applicable.
 - Candidates should arrive at the TIG Examination Centre at least 30 minutes before the start of the examination proper. Candidates arriving at the PRS Examination centre later than 15 minutes after the examination has started will not be admitted.
4. Examination Site Coordinator (ESC):
 - ESC will be stationed in the examination room to assist candidates and ensure that candidates adhere to the PRS Examination requirements, policies and procedures. Should you require any assistance, please approach ESC for help. Questions concerning the conduct of the examinations will not be entertained.
 - Candidates should listen carefully to and understand the instructions and directions given by ESC.
5. Admission and Attendance:
 - Candidates must present their original Admissions Ticket together with original identity documents (i.e. Identity Card or Passport) for verification before admission into the examination room. The ESC will deny admission to anyone who does not present a valid Admission Ticket and identity document.
 - The following information will be verified by ESC before admission into the examination room:
 - (a) Candidate's Full Name;
 - (b) IC No. or Passport No.; and
 - (c) Candidate Examination No. (to be obtained from relevant company or commerce in form 1).
 - Candidates will receive (a) and (b) for matching it corresponding to those printed on their identity documents will be learned from entering the examination room. Such candidates will be issued an absent NO record will be given.
 - All candidates must sign on the Attendance List for their attendance (signatures purposes, during which, candidates will be considered as absent).
6. Things Allowed to Bring into Examination Room:
 - Candidates are only allowed to bring with you Identity Card or Passport, non-programmable calculator and pen/pencil. Other personal belongings such as brief cases, hand phones, duly matched soft books and papers are not to be left at a designated place or unattended by the ESC.
 - Neither FIMM, the examination centre nor ESC will assume responsibility or liability for any loss, theft, or damage of your personal property.

2. Examination Results
- * The results will be made available to you via the relevant company that you registered with within one month from the examination date.
3. Misconduct
- * Candidates found to misbehave during the examination (such as copying other candidates' papers or receiving help, reading or writing the examination questions during a time not authorised by the EBC, or accessing to other sources from other sources, including oral or printed paper from the examination centre, passing in or out of supervision or other form of cheating, failing to follow the EBC's instructions, or not complying with FIMM's regulations, policies or procedures, etc.) may be dismissed from the examination process. In addition, you may be subjected to other forms of penalties of misconduct, including voiding of examination results, and suspension or revocation of your rights to sit for PRS Examination.
4. Reservation of Right during Emergency
- * FIMM may decide to change the date, time, or conditions of the administration of the examination, or cancel the administration of the examination, or choose to end the candidates' exams either entirely across the board or at a particular examination centre or centres if FIMM, in its judgment, deems it necessary that any such action is needed to protect the safety of the PRS Examination, or because administration of the examination or subsequent processing of the results is hindered by any factor that could not be reasonably prevented by the FIMM, including acts of God or other natural disasters and military authority. FIMM is not responsible or liable for any losses or other consequences arising from the additional events which are beyond its control.
 - * Should there be any changes in cancellation of examination session or reschedule due to the aforementioned cause, the relevant company will be notified and will have to register for another PRS Examination session at no additional costs. Such registration must be submitted to FIMM within one month from the examination date.
5. Policy Changes
- * FIMM may change the requirements, policies and procedures governing the PRS Examination from time to time. Changes, if any, will be communicated in these notes and the revised notes will be circulated to all relevant companies.
 - * Candidates are advised to check with respective relevant company to ensure that the latest version of the "Notes to Candidates" is made available.
6. Appeal
- * Requests for appeal, if any, must be submitted to the relevant company and received by FIMM within 14 days from the date of the examination result. The appeal request should be accompanied with a payment of RM20.00 as processing fee. Please contact the relevant company for further details and procedure.
 - * Requests for appeal received by FIMM after than 14 days will not be considered.
